YOUR RIGHTS UNDER GDPR (Global Data Privacy Regulation)

As a resident of EEA (European Economic Area) you have rights to request:

1. Access: A copy of the personal information we hold about you
2. Rectify: Any inaccuracies in your personal information be corrected
3. Erasure: Your personal information be erased, or be restricted for our use
4. Data Portability: transfer from one electronic processing system to another
5. Consent: Restrictions on processing your data or withdraw consent

YOUR RIGHTS UNDER CCPA (California Consumer Privacy Act)

California law grants California residents effective January 1st 2020, certain rights and imposes restrictions on particular business practices as stated below.

- Initial Notice: We will notify California residents the categories of personal information collected and the purposes for which this information is used.

- Request to Delete: California residents have the right to request deletion of their personal information that we have collected.
- Request to Know: California residents have the right to request their personal information that we have collected and are processing.
- Right to Non-Discrimination. The CCPA prohibits discrimination against California residents for exercising their rights under the CCPA.
- Do-Not-Sell. California residents have the right to opt-out of sale of their personal information. Please note that Perceptive Control Solutions has not sold any personal information nor intends to sell any information in the future.

Under the CCPA, a “sale” includes disclosing or making available to a third party personal information, in exchange for monetary compensation or other benefits or value. While we do not disclose personal information in exchange for monetary compensation, we may make certain categories of personal information available in order to receive certain benefits or services, such as when we make browsing information available to third party ad companies (through third party tags on our Sites) in order to improve and measure our ad campaigns and reach users with more relevant ads and content.
